



## **NGSA SUMMER SOCCER**

Summer Soccer is a joint effort between NGS A and the Habersham County Department of Parks and Recreation. The program is designed for players of all ages and skill levels. Games are played on small fields with fewer players so that players have a lot of touches on the ball. The season lasts from June 8 – July 17 with few practices and lots of games. The program is more laid back and less competitive than our fall and spring programs. In other words, it is designed for the kids to have fun!

Summer soccer is a great way to introduce new players to the sport as well as a way for experienced players to have an option to continue working on their game. The cost is minimal, \$50 dollars for players ages 4-7 and \$60 for players ages 8 and older. The registration fee includes a jersey and covers the cost of field maintenance, administrative costs and referees. All players are required to wear shirts, shorts, shoes (tennis shoes or cleats) socks and shin guards. All players will also need a soccer ball. For players ages 4-7, they will need a size 3 ball, ages 8-12 a size 4 ball and all others play with a size 5 ball.
